Embossing Template corner designs have five distinct elements:

1. 1 - 3 Corner Design Sizes
2. Center Image Shape
3. Design Line

Use one or more of the design elements to create strong simple designs or ornate delicate designs. Tracing and cutting is the technique shown, but the versatility of Embossing Templates will invite you to try markers, embossing with a stylus or sponge / ink over the template edges.



Corner Designs as used to create a unique envelope flap or decorative corners on paper.

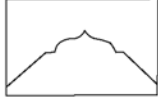
1. Select the Size of Corner Design desired.



You may choose to use a combination of designs or repeat design along edge.



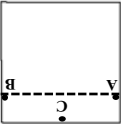
2. With sharp pencil Trace design on wrong side of paper or on inside of envelope flap.



3. Using small scissors, Cut on pencil line.

Design Line as used to create an arch or edge on stationary, note card or envelope.

1. On back of paper, approximately 1-3" down, make two small dots on edges of paper (A & B).



2. Make a dot (C) at center of top edge of paper. The 0- center on Art Deckle is ideal for this purpose.



3. Place either end of design line on dot A. Angle template Design Line from dots A to C and trace. (Repeat part of line if template does not reach C).

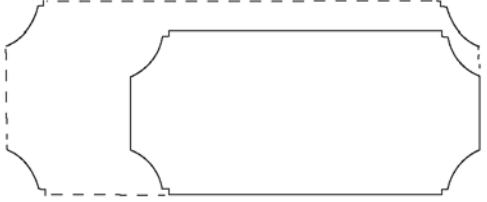


4. Reverse template and repeat same from B to C.

5. Cut along pencil line. Folded Note Card shown here.



Image Shape as used to create contrasting mats behind photos or rubber stamped impressions.



Change the size of the Image Shape to the size you need by simply sliding the template along a straight edge.

More complex Image Shapes (as no.1705) may be enlarged on a copier.

Use a ruler or straight edge to connect or lengthen straight lines.
